

# A Sad Story

Minul Islam (Shoeb) is the eldest son of his parents. Shoeb got married to Mukti before he came to Australia. For three/four years he has been struggling to manage his tuition fees as well as trying bring his wife here. He could not save enough money to sponsor her.

Shoeb managed to fulfill the requirements to apply for permanent residency in Australia. He did not add his wife in the residency application as he could not bring her here.

Last year he went to see his wife. When he got back from Bangladesh, he felt severe headache one day. He went to see doctor and he was diagnosed for two serious conditions.

- Shoeb has trouble with fluid circulation between his skull and the brain. This gave him the sever headache.
- There is also internal bleeding due to twisted nerve at the back of his head which is the major reason of his problem.

Doctors successfully established fluid circulation in his brain at the Westmead hospital. He recovered well that time. Second operation was critical and this technology is very new. He did not recover properly after the second operation and lost some of his senses.

He is now wheelchair bound. He can't talk properly, can't eat by himself. Recently his wife has given birth to their first child (daughter). We are trying to help him. His wife got temporary visa on medical grounds after waiting for 4 months but unfortunately she does not have enough money for the air ticket. Currently he is in St. Joseph hospital in Auburn under rehabilitation and waiting for his wife to come with the baby he hasn't seen yet.

Can we help this helpless man who is unable to ask for help himself?

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
