

1971 Liberation War Film Festival

Ouderland Memorial Committee (OMC) is going to organise a Liberation War Film Festival from February to April 2012 in all major cities in Australia. Ouderland BP, a Dutch-Australian, who planned and directed a number of guerilla operations in Dhaka, and provided Mukti Bahini with food, medicine and shelter during Bangladesh Liberation War in 1971. Mr Ouderland was the only foreigner who received the gallantry award titled 'Briprotik'.
